This program is designed to make youth members aware that all nations are closely related through natural resources, and that we are interdependent with our world environment.

Complete requirement 3 from the Baloo the Builder adventure by constructing a bird feeder or a bird house as one of the options. Participate in a den or pack conservation project in addition to the above.
Webelos Requirements Earn the Building a Better World adventure. Earn the Into the Wild adventure. Earn the Into the Woods adventure. Earn the Earth Rocks adventure. Complete requirements 1, 3a, and 3b in the Adventures in Science adventure. Participate in a den or pack conservation project in addition to the above.
